One Way Farm Children's Home has developed programs to further the potential of all children and is certified through the Ohio Department of Job & Family Services.

The One Way Farm serves as a home for abandoned and abused children and has served over 8,000 children to date.

Providing counseling for children and families for reunification.

Providing medical and dental care for children in crisis.

Provide housing, education, psychological and medication evaluations.

UPDATE

1. For the fiscal year 2007-2008 One Way Farm Children's Home has worked with many children with the help of our local community, corporations, foundations, and concerned individuals.
2. The ages of the children who come to us now have dropped considerably; the average age is 9-13 years, down from 6-18. Percentages also reflect issues we see regularly: 25% are MRDD, 50% are dysfunctional and 25% have multiple disabilities directly related to their abusive pasts. Of the total population, 99% have histories of sexual abuse.
3. Receipt of a foundation grant enabled One Way Farm Children's Home to purchase new bedroom furniture for the New Dawn Shelter.
4. The Animal Therapy Barn has untold benefits.
5. Our Summer School has continued to serve its purpose to the educational needs of children. This program helps in securing underprivileged children the opportunity to enter the work force.
6. Donation and construction of a new 30x70 facility allowing the reopening of the Thrift Store.
7. New landscaping with labor and plants donated around facility and shelters.
8. Awarded by the Better Business Bureau the seal of an Accredited Charity.
