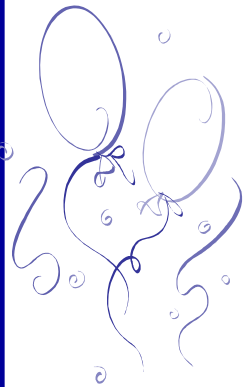

Many of you may already know, Ms. Condo was recently inducted into the Ohio Senior Citizens Hall of Fame, during a ceremony at the Capitol Theatre in Columbus on Tuesday, May 26, 2009, along with 12 other exceptional Ohioans. In 1976 One Way Farm Children's Home was founded, a non-profit organization that provides residential care for youths who have been abused, neglected or abandoned or who are mentally challenged or homeless. Approximately 8,000 children have found shelter and direction at One Way Farm Children's Home. One Way Farm Children's Home includes an animal education therapy barn, an office complex building and a barn that houses the thrift store, which raises funds for the children's clothing and education.

Ms. Condo has received numerous awards for her services, including the Mason Humanitarian Award, the Business Person of the Year Award from the Fairfield Chamber of Commerce and Woman of Excellence Award.

Ms. Condo's dedication to serving abused, abandoned, lost or troubled children has made, and is still making a difference in the lives of families and the community.
